REGULAR SELECTMEN'S MEETING MONDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2012, 7:00 P.M. ASHFORD TOWN OFFICES MINUTES

1. Call to order at 7:00 p.m.
2. Members present: Fletcher, Falletti, Zambo
3. Hear from the Public: no members of the public wishing to be heard at this time
4. First Selectman's briefing
 - Small Claims Court action produced an agreement between the Town and Computer Tamers awarding the town \$4,660 payable by January 3, 2013.
5. Hear from Boards, Commissions, Committees
 - The Tax Collector reported that a shredder purchased last spring from W.B. Mason is inhabited by a demon. W.B. Mason will replace the shredder.
6. Zambo moved acceptance of minutes of Regular Meeting of 10/1/2012. Fletcher seconded the motion which passed. Falletti was excused from that meeting so did not cast a vote.

 - a. Committee/Commission appointments
 - b. Tax refunds: Zambo moved approval of the following tax refunds citing CGS 12-129 – Jessica Bates in the amount of \$40.74 and Francis Mann in the amount of \$63.59. Falletti seconded the motion which passed.
 - c. Tax Collector re: anticipated tax sales: Members of the BOS and the Tax Collector discussed a draft tax sale policy.
9. Remarks for the good of the Board
 - Zambo reported that the Senior Center Advisory Committee agenda has been set. The next meeting is scheduled for 10/27/12
 - The BOS discussed the loss of funding for the Small Cities sponsored food bank. Fletcher advised the BOS that Small Cities grant administrator Peter Huckins is preparing a letter to be sent to food bank participants regarding loss of funding. The BOS discussed the food bank run between Ashford Social Services, United Baptist Church and St. Philip Church. Food bank funding possibilities will be explored.
 - The BOS discussed the placement of political signs. Signs are only to be displayed at the Transfer Station when someone is superintending them. Removal of inappropriately placed political signs will be followed up on by the First Selectman.
