The electors and citizens qualified to vote in Town Meetings in the Town of Ashford, Connecticut are hereby notified and warned that a Public Hearing and Special Town Meeting will be held at the Knowlton Memorial Hall, 25 Pompey Hollow Road, Ashford, CT 06278 on Wednesday, August 31, 2016 at 7:30 p.m.

The agenda for the Public Hearing is as follows:

1. To choose a moderator for said hearing; and
2. To receive public comment regarding a petition received by the Ashford Town Clerk on August 12, 2016 requesting discussion and voting on the following: "For the Town of Ashford to apply for a matching historic restoration grant of \$50,000 with The State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) to rehabilitate the interior of the Tremko/Stebbins House, a town-owned building. When completed, the Tremko/Stebbins House would be used for the purpose of a town museum per a previous matching grant of \$15,000 from the State Historic Preservation Office which helped to rehabilitate the exterior and was completed in June 2015."

At their special meeting of 8/22/2016 the Board of Finance recommended non-support of an appropriation of \$100,000 for the purpose of facilitating an application to the State Historic Preservation Office to perform interior rehabilitation of the Tremko House.

The agenda for the Special Town Meeting is as follows:

1. To choose a moderator for said meeting; and
2. To act on a petition received by the Ashford Town Clerk requesting that the Town of Ashford through its Board of Selectmen, apply for a matching grant in the amount of \$50,000 from the State Historic Preservation Office to rehabilitate the interior of the Tremko/Stebbins House.
