INLAND WETLANDS AND WATERCOURSES COMMISSION MEETING:**

**Special Meeting  
Tuesday, June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2017  
7:00 P.M.**

**Present:** Lenny Liguore (Chair), John Barclay, David Rechel, Raymon Fenn, Peter Piecyk, Bob Michel (alt.), Kenneth Garee (alt.). Also present: Joseph Theroux, Wetlands Enforcement Officer, Michael Gardner, Land Use Administrator.

**Call to Order:** 7:15 p.m. by Chairman Liguore.

**Seating of alternates:** Michel was seated for Lipstreu. Garee was seated for Zulick

**Minutes of May 2<sup>nd</sup>, regular meeting:** Fenn moved, and Rechel seconded a motion to accept the minutes of the meeting of May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017 as written. The motion passed unanimously.

**New Business:** Show Cause Hearing on a violation of the Ashford Inland Wetlands & Watercourses Regulations at 229-231 Ashford Center Road. Contractor: Stephen Krukoff; Owner: Webster Boy Scout Camp. The enforcement officer, Joseph R. Theroux issued a Notice of Violation and Cease and Desist order, dated June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017 to Stephen Krukoff, concerning excavation activities at the Camp that could cause significant impact to the immediately adjacent wetland ecosystem. Commission members expressed concern about water quality issues that might emerge as a result of gradual long-term excavation, as well as short-term projects. It was moved by Rechel and seconded by Piecyk to keep the Violation in place, and lift the Cease and Desist order with the following conditions:

- No work should continue within 100 ft. of the wetlands, to be delineated by a soil scientist.
- The Enforcement Officer should inspect flagging of the wetlands before work continues.
- An application should be submitted for proposed projects that might affect the wetlands.
- Soil scientist and engineering reports should be submitted to the commission as part of the permit application.

The motion passed unanimously.
