

**TOWN OF ASHFORD, CONNECTICUT  
INLAND WETLANDS AND WATERCOURSES COMMISSION MEETING:**

**Regular Meeting  
Tuesday, October 2, 2018  
7:00 P.M.**

**Present:** Leonard Liguore (Chair), Raymond Fenn, John Barclay, Richard Zulick, Robert G. Michel (alt.) Kenneth Garee (alt.). Also present: Joseph Theroux (Wetlands Enforcement Officer)

**Guests:** Daniel Donahue, property owner

**Call to Order:** The Chair called the meeting to order at 7:02 P.M.

**Seating of alternates:** Garee was seated for Piccyk, while Michel was seated for Lipstreu.

**Minutes of the Tuesday, September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018 meeting:** Barklay moved, and Fenn seconded a motion to accept the minutes of the July 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting as written. The motion passed unanimously.

**Old Business:**

**Permit application number W-05-18: two-car garage installation at 180 Mansfield Road.** After a description by Donahue it was apparent that the work would require minimal tree cutting, and as the site is well vegetated down to the river there is little chance of erosion and sedimentation. A motion to approve the application was made by Zulick with the condition that hay bales be used on the south and west corner of the site, which would allow for protection of the wetlands during the construction work. After a second by Michel, the motion passed unanimously.

**Timber Harvest notification – landing at Nagy Road**

For this harvest, identified as on tax map 40, block A, lot # 14, no new information has been received from Mr. Person. No action was possible.

**New Business:**

A motion to approve the proposed schedule for the commission's meetings for 2019 was moved by Fenn, seconded by Barklay. and passed unanimously.

**Agent's report:** A letter of inquiry dated September 11<sup>th</sup> was sent to Andrea Palmer about Lot 172 at the North end of Ashford Lake Drive. Her request was to extend her beach on Ashford Lake beyond its present extent to allow access for Kayaks. Theroux indicated that the permit for the existing beach should be viewed as allowing the extension. The commission emphasized the use of washed sand to protect the lake.

**Members' comments:** none

**Adjournment:** Barclay moved to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Zulick. The motion passed unanimously in favor. The meeting was adjourned at ~7:21 P.M.
