

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Transfer Station stickers, displayed on the lower driver's side corner of your windshield entitle Ashford property owners use of the Transfer Station. Punch cards, which are distributed with your first Transfer Station sticker, are needed for disposal of tires and Freon appliances (e.g., refrigerators, air conditioners). Please present your punch card to transfer station personnel prior to disposing of these items. Additional or replacement stickers are available from the Selectmen's Office.

No hazardous waste will be accepted at the Ashford Transfer Station. Hazardous waste may be disposed of at the Household Hazardous Waste Facility located on Hancock Road in Willington. This facility is open from 9 am-2 pm on the first and third Saturday of each month mid-April to mid-November (closed 7/2 and 9/3). You may contact them at (860)684-3163.

When unloading materials brought for disposal, please turn off your vehicle.

Political campaigning will only be permitted in a clearly marked area on the lower level of the Transfer Station.

We cannot accept fill, gravel, cement, brick, junk cars, trucks, motorcycles, house and commercial demolition debris.

Lower Level Concrete Pads

These are the materials for which you are being issued a punch card. You will be allowed to dispose of 8 tires and 4 Freon appliances over a three-year period. Supplemental punch cards are available through the Selectmen's Office at a cost of \$20. The following materials are to be placed on the appropriately marked concrete pads:

Consumer electronics: CRT monitors, computers, peripheral computer equipment and devices, printers, fax machines, copiers, microwave ovens and televisions.

White Goods: containing CFC's (refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners) should be placed upright on the appropriate concrete pad.

Tires: up to 20" are accepted and can be placed under the first overhang next to the compactor.

Upper Level

PUT 'n TAKE and BOOK SHEDS

Are located on the upper level of the Transfer Station. They contain items which may be of use to others such as furniture, toys, books, etc. Feel free to take any items you may need. Please do not deposit any items in need of repair - those should go directly to a container to be disposed of. Check with Charlie or Tony if you are unsure of what to do with an item.

Upper Level and Roofed Roll-off Container Area

The disposal areas and containers located on the upper Transfer Station level are labeled as follows:

Brush: nothing larger than 3" in diameter is accepted for disposal in the brush pile.

Leaves: can be disposed of in the area located next to the brush pile (we cannot accept leaves in bags or grass clippings).

Mattresses: must be placed in the container located next to the leaf pile.

Scrap Metals: which consist of ferrous metals, aluminum, brass, copper, lead, chromium, tin, nickel or alloys.

Wood: clean construction debris, firewood, wooden pallets, furniture, etc.

Bulky Waste: couches, toys, sheetrock, asphalt shingles, ceramics, place glass, latex paint (dried), etc.

Municipal Solid Waste: disposal of household garbage.

Oil and Antifreeze: are to be disposed of in the clearly marked receptacles.

Propane tanks: May be left near the office.

Automotive batteries: May be left near the office.

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

All items eligible for single stream recycling may be commingled and disposed of in the single stream compactor located adjacent to the garbage compactor or in the container located next to the bulky waste containers. Acceptable single stream items include:

- Newspapers and magazines
- Cardboard and paperboard boxes
- Paper bags
- Junk mail
- Phone books/catalogues
- White and colored paper
- Envelopes (window ok)
- File folders
- White, green and brown glass
- Tin cans
- Aluminum (cans, foil, pots/pans)
- Juice and milk cartons
- Plastic milk jugs and soda bottles
- Detergent bottles
- All #3 to #7 plastics
- Small metals
- Empty aerosol cans
- Plastic buckets and crates

MATERIAL NOT ACCEPTED AS SINGLE STREAM

Needles, syringes, trash or bagged material, containers with food waste and hazardous or biohazard waste.
